Capbreton Surfer was born from the sea and lives by it. The Capbreton submarine canyon — one of the most unique in the world — reminds us every day that our activity depends on a preserved environment. This privilege carries responsibility.

Environment

- 100% eco-friendly cleaning products: certified (Ecocert) and natural alternatives (white vinegar, baking soda)
- Zero single-use plastics: wooden storage lockers, reusable water bottles for staff and clients
- Systematic waste sorting: 4 labelled bins (cardboard, plastic, food waste, sanitary waste)
- Progressive replacement of all light bulbs with low-energy LEDs
- Triple glazing on entrance door and roller shutter to limit heat loss
- Ocean and marine environment awareness during every surf lesson: biodiversity, Capbreton canyon, eco-responsible practices

Sustainable mobility

- Active promotion of car-free alternatives: cycling paths, Txik Txak Landes bus, secure bike parking 200m away (lifeguard post)
- Information on nearby electric vehicle charging stations
- Purchase of refurbished equipment (Back Market) to limit electronic waste

Social and societal

- Gender equality: identical pay scale for equivalent positions, zero discrimination in hiring
- Anti-harassment and anti-discrimination policy: reporting procedure integrated into staff welcome booklet
- Inclusion policy: apprentice BPJEPS surf instructor with disability status (RQTH) since 2026
- Working conditions: schedules communicated one month in advance, work clothes provided, holiday vouchers accepted
- Accessibility: registered on Acceslibre, PMR-trained reception staff, partnership with Ted Surf School for adaptive surfing

Goals 2026-2028

- 1 Obtain the Destination d'Excellence label (Qualité Tourisme) in 2026
- 2 Complete the replacement of all light bulbs with LEDs by end of 2026
- 3 Set up ink cartridge refilling (Cartridge World)

- 4 Conduct a carbon footprint assessment by 2027
- 5 Formalise a partnership with a beach cleanup association (Surfrider Foundation)
- 6 Enrich the "How to get here" page with all sustainable mobility options
